(BUS LANES) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2014

(WESTGATE ROAD VARIATION) ORDER 2022

The Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 19 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- The City of Newcastle upon Tyne (Bus Lanes) Traffic Regulation Order 2014 ("the 2014 Order") is hereby varied as follows -
 - (a) the addition into Schedule 3 (c) thereto of the item specified in the Schedule to this Order; and
 - (b) the deletion of Item 1 from Schedule 3 (d) thereto.
- 2. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on 25th July 2022, and may be cited as the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (Bus Lanes) Traffic Regulation Order 2014 (Westgate Road Variation Order 2022.
